

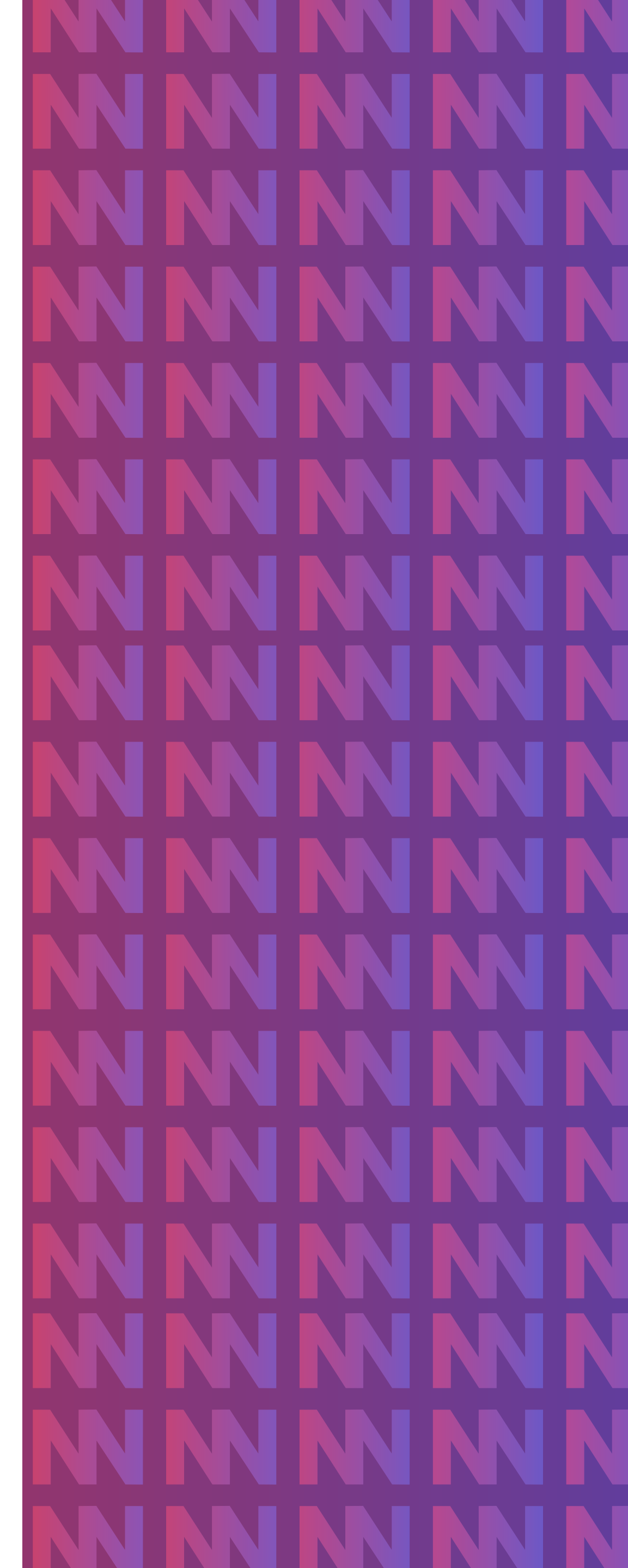

What is Learning.Connected?

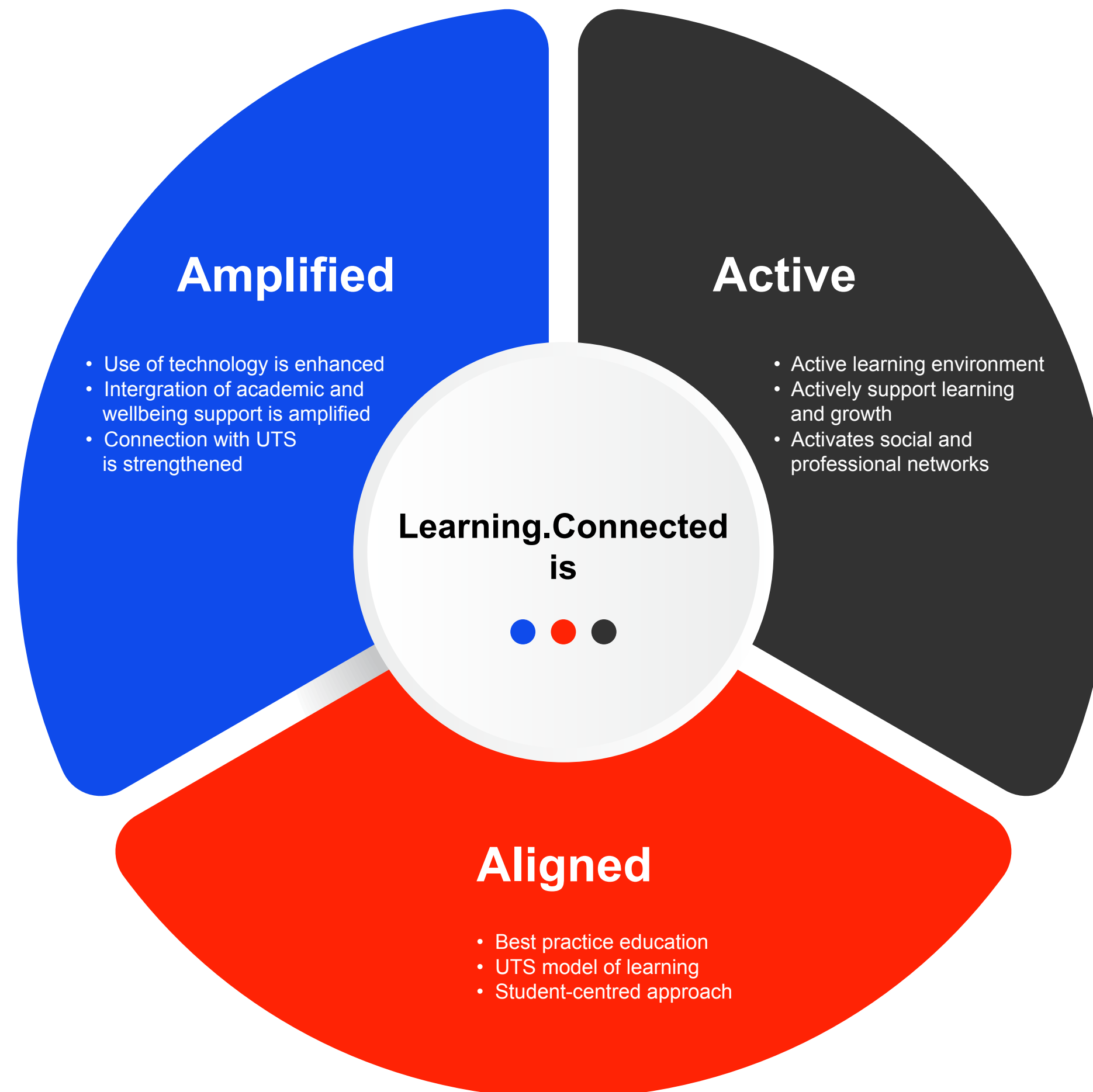
Learning.Connected offers students the opportunity to:

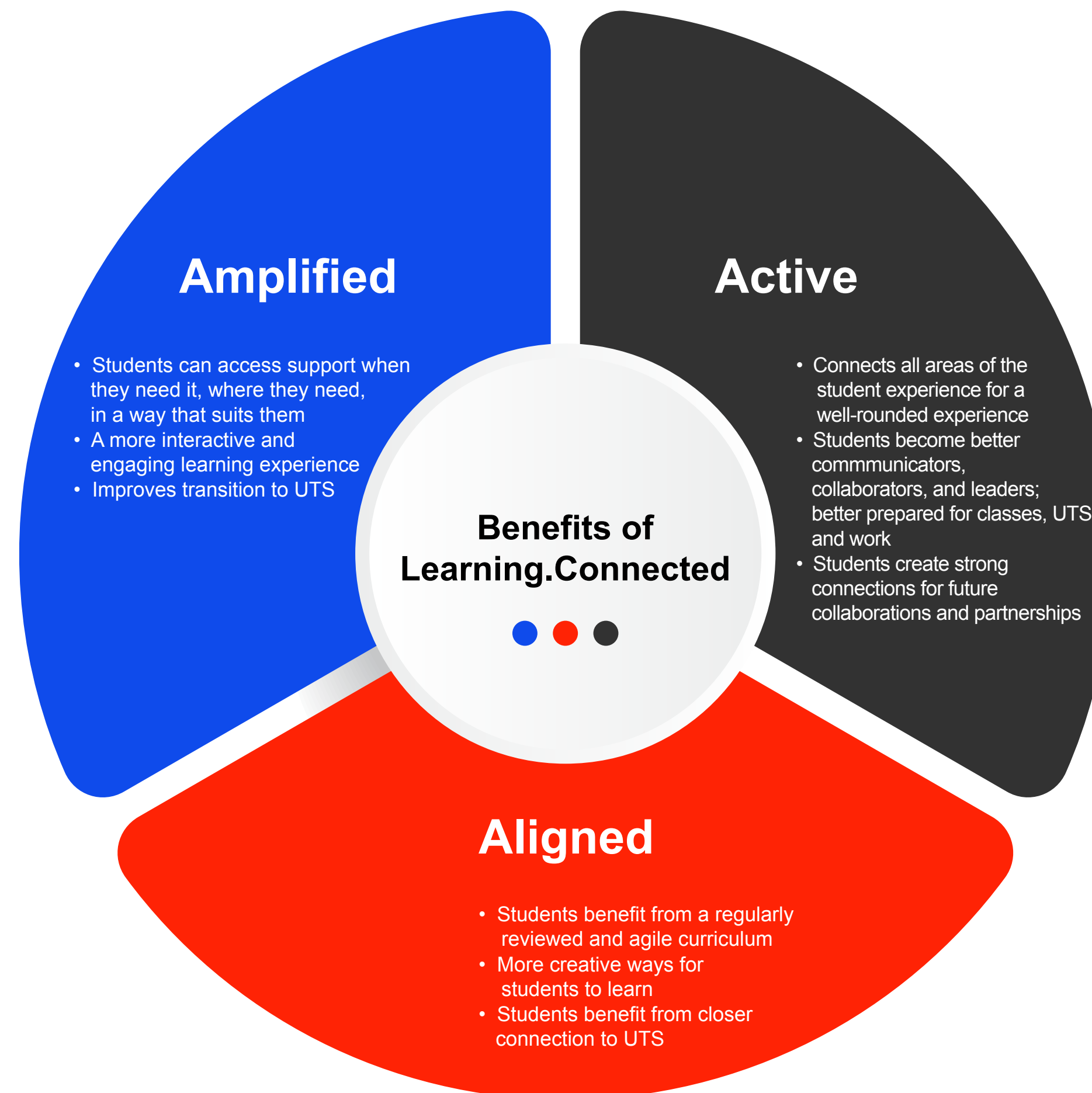

UTS College launch inspiring new way of learning in 2022

This year, in an exciting decision to rethink the education and pathway experience for both domestic and international students in Australia and abroad, UTS College has launched a new model of learning for its UTS Foundation Studies, Diploma and Pre-Master's programs.

Called **Learning.Connected**, the model offers students an integrated experience of live and independent learning, fully supported by UTS College's comprehensive range of support and student welfare services, and including enhanced social, leadership, and advocacy opportunities for students.

"Our approach to student learning focuses on building the student's capabilities as independent learners, as much as building their discipline knowledge. Our focus is preparing students for success, initially at UTS but ultimately for the world of work where taking the initiative, collaborating with other and achieving great outcomes, sets you apart from other graduates. Our curriculum is innovative and an inspiring way to learn at UTS College," says Tim Laurence, Dean of Studies, UTS College. "All our diploma curricula has been renewed and redeveloped to provide a highly interactive and engaging experience of learning."

Built on a blended or hybrid model of learning, Learning.Connected is backed by research and assists students to develop critical thinking, communication, collaboration and leadership skills in a nurturing and supported environment – skills that prepare students for their work future.

With videos, simulations, discussions, quizzes, concept checks and 24/7 access to learning materials, plus active feedback from teachers and peers, students are guided and supported to develop confidence as independent learners and skilled communicators, ready and prepared for UTS and their career.

"I think the number one most valuable aspect of Learning.Connected is the pre-tutorial learning," says Bianca Basset, UTS College diploma student. 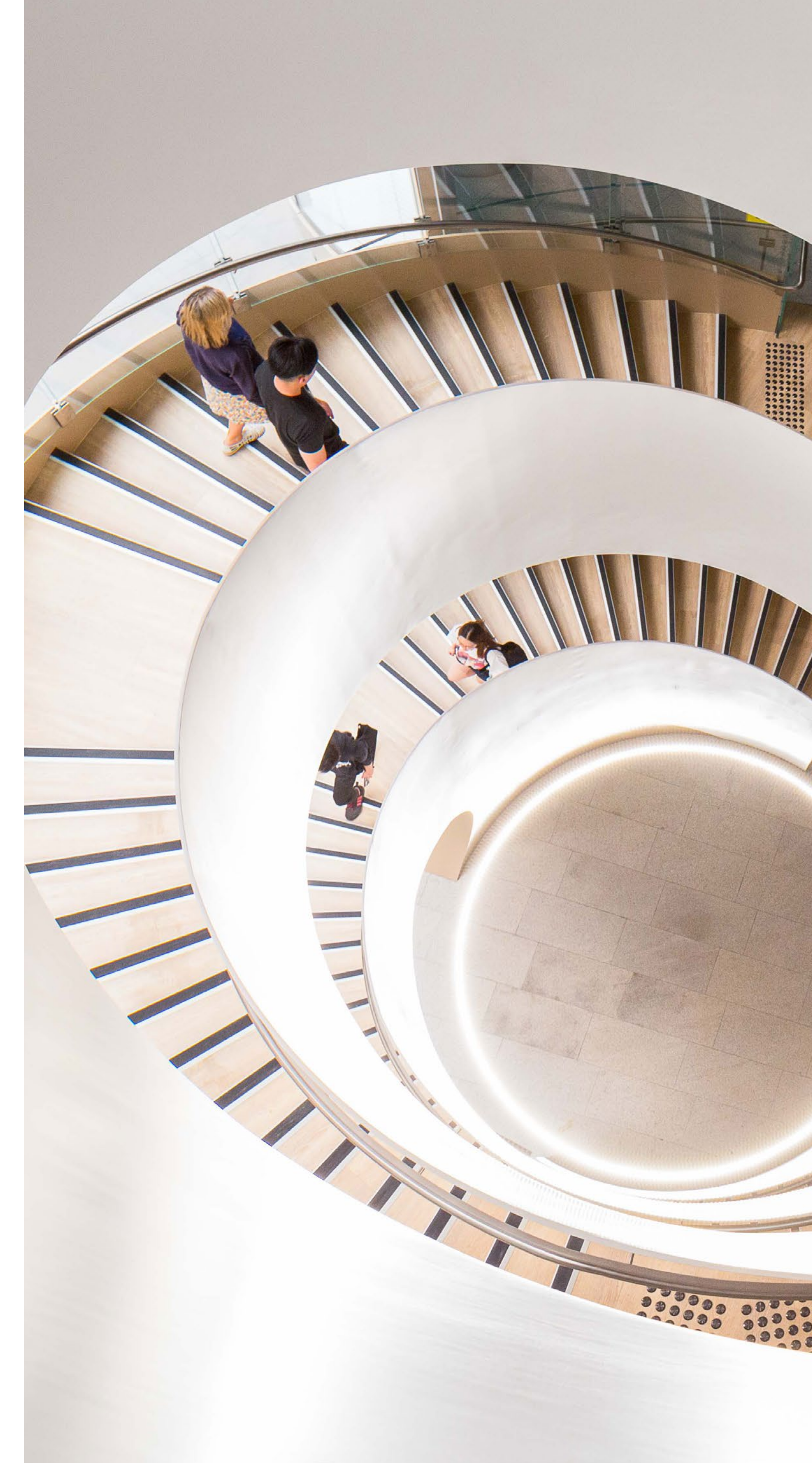
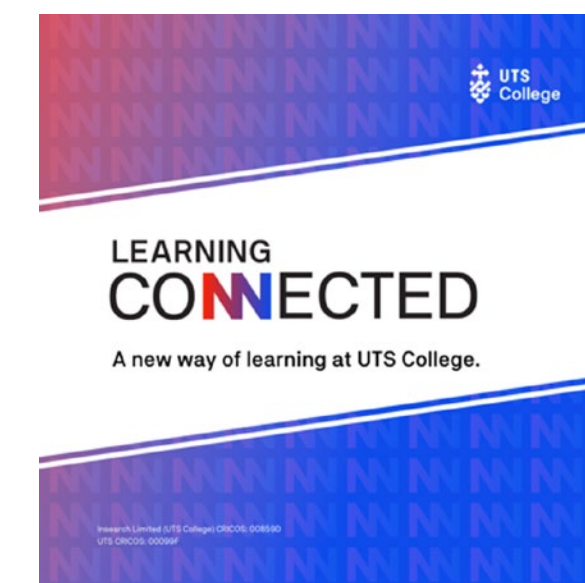
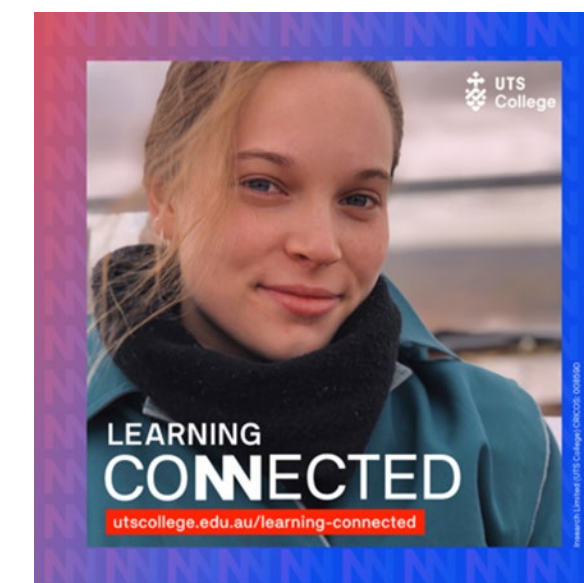
